Banstead Leisure Centre Link Road, Banstead, Surrey

Background

Cole Easdon Consultants (CEC) were appointed by Deloitte, the project managers for this project who represent Reigate & Banstead Borough Council, to undertake the detailed design of the new 430m link road between Merland Rise and Marbles Way.

The new road across existing parkland is required to serve the new leisure centre to the north and a new residential development to the south.
